We know that many of the 360 commitments made by delegates at the 2013 Summit have been achieved, but there are likely some, more audacious and impactful commitments that could use a kick start to reach their full potential. So we want you to choose one of your “3 Things” that needs funding to initiate or take it to the next level.

Your 2013 Youth Ag-Summit Committee and supporting partners want to see all 360 things accomplished and you achieve your goals.

We also want to celebrate the 2-year anniversary of the Summit as we approach the eve of the 2015 Youth Ag-Summit in Canberra, Australia this August. The application window for this is short because we want you to act now – choose your best “thing” and apply today!

Eligible Applicants

This funding opportunity is available to any delegate who participated in the 2013 Youth Ag-Summit.

Applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Integrity of the proposed initiative within the scope of the Youth Ag-Summit
- The impact and reach of the initiative in the community or region

Available Funding

Ten (10) awards of up to \$1,000 each (CAD) are available to successful applicants.

Eligible Expenses

The event or initiative must support the public delivery of the “3 Things” the applicant took away from the Youth Ag-Summit.

Exclusions

This grant will not support:

- Events or initiatives that benefit an individual and all funds awarded must be used to cover expenses incurred in the delivery of the event or initiative;

- Capital projects/capital expenditures (i.e. equipment, machinery);
- Administrative fees or salaries.

Duration

Monies awarded must be spent and reported on by March 31, 2016.

Application Format

An application for funding can be submitted online at <http://apply.4-h-canada.ca>
Applications will open at 10am EDT on August 8th and close at 12:00 midnight EDT on September 14th. 4-H Canada does not assume responsibility for any computer errors. It is the applicant's sole responsibility to confirm receipt.

Successful applicants will be notified by October 6, 2015.

Reporting

Any Youth Ag-Summit alumnus that receives funding is required to submit a report online within 30 days of completion. This report should provide supporting documentation of how the funding was used, photos and a 500 word summary that details the impact and outcomes of the initiative/event. Reports will be submitted through the same on-line account where the application was submitted and the story and photos may be used in 4-H Canada and/or Bayer CropScience publications.
